- 1. Clear all your browsing data before you enter any URL using Ctrl+Shift+Delete. Make sure you change it to clear data "From All Time."
- 2. Copy and paste the following URL into the address bar on chrome: http://stjohnsschools.schoology.com

Enter this as the email address: sXXXXXX@stjohns.k12.fl.us (X's being the student ID number) and click next.

- 3. A second login box will appear. Use the username and password from school (no stjohns.k12.fl.us necessary). You should successfully be logged in at this point.
