BOOKSHARE

Students with an IEP for print disability, ADHD, and physical disability holding books can use Bookshare to access 690,807 titles in fiction and nonfiction, including textbooks. SUPPLEMENTAL TECH TIPS

You can use the screen capture feature in PowerPoint to record audio and video. Go to INSERT and click SCREEN RECORDING. I am available to help if you have any questions.
