Dear Parents and Guardians,

As I write, you should now have received your student's first Interim Report Card for the year. This is an important time to reflect and communicate as a family. The goal is for students to develop their learning style and become more comfortable with the writing process. All students in advanced classes should be reading outside of the curriculum in order to improve their vocabulary and comprehension. Our goal, through STEM, is to go well beyond the Florida State Assessment (FSA).

We began our Eagle/Inquiry Hour vision last Wednesday and will continue to develop it moving forward. Students assigned to an Inquiry Hour get a chance to work on a community project with the idea of applying learning. It is new for some but ultimately will help with creativity and expression. These groups will rotate so I ask that you engage your son or daughter with questions relative to their assignment.

Many of our after school clubs and activities also opened last week and the offerings will continue to grow based on student interest. This time is important as it provides us with the opportunity, in smaller groups, to make deeper connections with our students and help them develop their skills. These sessions are often the most rewarding for students and teachers.

Finally, we will host our Curriculum Chat/Open House events this week and next. The important ideas from these sessions center around communicating with teachers and understanding how we, as parents, can support our student's learning. Both events will begin promptly at 5:30pm in the Auditorium. I look forward to seeing you there.


