## Message from the King.....

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Firstly, I want to clarify issues related to testing and how we are to move forward. The district vision here is that students are not punished in any way due to the technology issues we experienced last week. At this time, we have stopped all District Examinations. Please note that testing on Florida State Assessment, Algebra, Geometry, Civics, Biology and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Science is all done on a different platform; therefore, we anticipate those sessions going well.

We begin FSA testing with our 6<sup>th</sup> graders next week and I ask that you work to best prepare your son/daughter for these sessions. In many cases, confidence is key. Our students are well prepared if they focus and emotionally commit for the duration of the examination. We want them to show what they've learned and in doing so, I know they will perform well. It can be a stressful time.

Secondly, I want to inform all of my new role with our District, effective July 1<sup>st</sup>. I have accepted a position as Associate Superintendent for Accountability, but I do so with a heavy heart. I've thoroughly enjoyed my time here as Principal and I'm proud of the work our students and teachers do every day. I'm particularly proud of the STEM Certification as it speaks to the connection needed between school, families and the community. In my new role, I will focus on supporting Title 1 Schools, and thus I plan to stay connected to Sebastian whilst supporting the incoming Principal. As a parent here myself, I also know how important it is to continue pushing Sebastian forward. It is a remarkable place and I feel lucky to have been part of the vision here. The support, in particular, from the PTO and you as parents has been incredible. Our District Leaders will be here at SMS this Thursday 4/25 at 2:15pm to solicit input on what we'd like to see in our new leader. ## The Penny War Returns to SMS! April 22 thru May 1, 2019


