SJCSD Returning Student Verifications

Attention all parents and guardians! The St. Johns County School District is going paperless; instead of updating paper forms during the back-to-school orientation events, all parents are now required to review forms and make updates online. You should have received an email from SJCSD with instructions and links, but if you did not, you can visit the SJCSD website at http://www.stjohns.k12.fl.us/student/enrollment/ and click on "Register Online for 2019-2020" to begin the process. Rising 6th and 9th grade students must provide proof of residence documentation; all other students complete a standard verification form. The Returning Student Verification Form MUST be completed online before your child's homeroom and class schedule can be finalized for 2019-2020. Also, if you are moving over the summer, you will need to re-register your child as a "new student" through the SJCSD website in the link referenced above. Thank you for helping to ensure a smooth start to the 2019-2020 school year!

TDAP Immunizations Needed for Rising 7th Graders by August 9, 2019

The Tdap immunization shot is required for all 7th graders and must be recorded on a Florida 680 form. As soon as your student receives this shot, the form can be dropped off at the SMS Front Office, faxed to 904-547-3845, or emailed to Becky Colvin. If the school does not re-ceive a record of this immunization by August 9, 2019, your student will not be allowed to attend school. If you do not have a family physician, services are available at the St. Johns County Health Department. Please call (904) 209-3250 for hours and location. If you have additional ques-tions, please contact the SJCSD Director for Health Services at (904) 547-7628.

Any SMS student wishing to try out for sports teams at SMS must have a physical on file dated within one year. SMS Yearbooks on Sale!


