For the first time in 15 years, a total of 18 members of the SMS Jr. Thespian Society participated in the District 1 Florida Jr. Thespians Festival (AKA "Thestival") at Lake Asbury Jr. High School in Green Cove Springs on Sat-

urday December 7. Students performed in 13 different events, and 11 of our performances were judged as "Superior" (2) or "Excellent" (9). Superior performances automatically qualify for the State Festival held in Orlando in February, and SMS will send 4 of the 9 excellent performances to States as well.

As a new after-school club this year at SMS, our Jr. Thespian Society was competing against 21 other schools, most of which offer drama as an elective class. Kudos and thanks to Ms. Ralin Trosclair for her excellent work in sponsoring Jr. Thespians at SMS this year and preparing our students so well in a short amount of time.
