TDAP Immunizations Needed for Rising 7th Graders by August 7, 2020

The Tdap immunization shot is required for all 7th graders and must be recorded on a Florida 680 form. As soon as your student receives this shot, the form can be dropped off at the SMS Front Office, faxed to 904-547-3845, or emailed to Becky Colvin. If the school does not re-ceive a record of this immunization by August 7, 2020, your student will not be allowed to attend school. If you do not have a family physician, services are available at the St. Johns County Health Department. Please call (904) 209-3250 for hours and location.
