




# Rephrasing Test Questions

WRITING IT IN YOUR OWN WORDS.

**REPHRASE A TEST QUESTION BY...**  
USING WHAT, WHY, OR HOW.

## ORIGINAL TEST QUESTION

What is the most likely reason the author included a map of Africa in the selection?



## REPHRASED QUESTION

Why did the author choose a map of Africa for the text?

**The rephrased question uses simple language.**
