
Rephrasing Test Questions

Sometimes test questions are phrased in a way that doesn't make sense. One way to better understand test questions is by rephrasing them or writing them in a different way.



REPHRASE A TEST QUESTION BY...

WRITING IT IN YOUR OWN WORDS.

REPHRASE A TEST QUESTION BY...

USING WHAT, WHY, OR HOW.

ORIGINAL TEST QUESTION

What is the most likely reason the author included a map of Africa in the selection?

REPHRASED QUESTION

Why did the author choose a map of Africa for the text?

The rephrased question uses simple language.

When you take your test and you don't understand what a question is asking, try rephrasing it in your own words!
