


PE class is designed to help students improve their overall health and fitness, setting them up for success in life. Students are expected to:

ICT class equips students with essential technology skills to support their future academic and career goals. Throughout the course, students will develop proficiency in:


- Web Design & Multimedia Creating and managing digital content.

- Databases & Internet Communications Understanding data organization and online communication tools
- Cybersecurity Learning how to protect digital information
- Computer Programming Developing coding skills for problemsolving and innovation

At the end of the course, students will take an exam that can earn an industry certification
















In STEM, all students experience:

Band

Band class is designed to help students, including those with little or no prior experience, develop fundamental music skills. Students will learn:

- Instrument Techniques Proper playing techniques for various instruments.
- Music Reading & Theory Understanding notes, rhythms, and musical expressions.
- Ensemble Performance Playing together as a group to create cohesive music.
- Students can choose to play instruments from three main sections:
- Brass Trumpet, French horn, baritone, trombone, tuba
- Woodwind Flute, clarinet, saxophone
- Percussion Snare drum, bells, bass drum, timpani

Orchestra





This class is designed to help students, even those with little or no prior experience, develop fundamental skills on string instruments. Students will learn:

- Instrument Techniques Proper playing posture, fingering, and bowing (for orchestral strings)
- Music Reading & Theory Understanding notes, rhythms, and musical structure
- Ensemble & Solo Performance Developing skills to play both individually and as part of a group

Students can choose to learn one of the following string instruments:

- Violin
- Viola
- Cello
- Bass


ART



This class allows students to explore a wide range of artistic media and techniques while developing their creativity and skills. Throughout the course, students will experiment with:

- **Drawing** Using pencils, charcoal, and other materials to create expressive and detailed works.
- **Painting** Learning color theory and various painting techniques with watercolors, acrylics, and more.
- Printmaking Creating unique prints using different methods.
- Collage Combining textures and materials to form creative compositions.

Students can take this course throughout all years of middle school, and all necessary supplies are provided.



Guitar



This class is designed to help students, even those with little or no prior experience, develop fundamental skills on the guitar. Students will learn:

- Basic Playing Techniques Proper hand positioning, strumming, and fingerpicking
- Music Reading & Chords Understanding tablature, chord progressions, and notation
- Ensemble & Solo Performance Developing confidence in playing both individually and in a group setting
- Guitars are provided for students, and the class includes two performances outside of school hours to showcase their progress

Theatre





Drama class introduces students to the fundamentals of theater performance, helping them develop confidence, creativity, and communication skills. No prior experience is required. Students will learn:

- Acting Techniques Voice projection, body movement, and character development
- Stage Presence Understanding blocking, expression, and audience engagement
- Script Reading & Performance Developing storytelling skills through rehearsals and live performances
- The class includes out-of-school performances, allowing students to showcase their talents and apply their learning in a real theatrical setting
